Warm weather – important information

Dear Parent/Carer,

In light of the weather warnings in place this week (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday), we want to ensure that all children remain safe and comfortable at Gracelands Nursery School.

What we will do:

- Ensure the school; building is ventilated as well as possible
- Keep lighting off where possible to reduce heat
- Encourage children to drink cold water regularly throughout the day – topping up their water bottles
- Keep physical activity to a minimum while the warm weather remains
- Significantly limit time outside, especially during the afternoons. Where we do go outside for short periods, the shaded areas will be utilised

Please can you:

- Ensure your child wears loose, light clothing
- Ensure your child has a water bottle
- Respond to phone communication from us should you need to collect your child if they become unwell or struggle particularly with the heat

Parent choice:

- We remain open and hope to see all the children at nursery. However, you know your child best and if you feel that they may struggle too much at nursery with the high temperatures, please let us know by phone if you would prefer for them to stay at home.
- There is no expectation but if your child attends all day, you may collect your child earlier than usual if you feel that would be beneficial for them.
