on the spot)

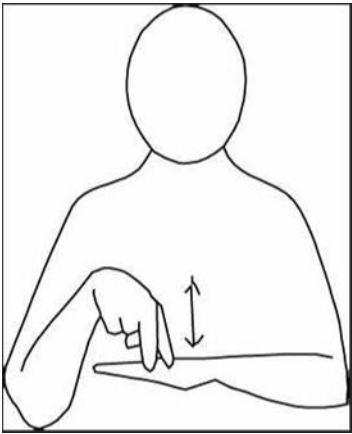
Hop little bunnies...hop, hop, hop

What to do at home together:

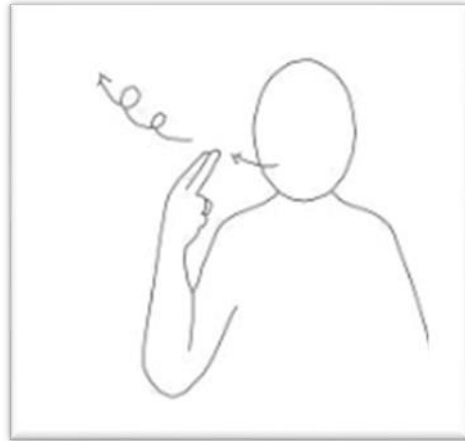
- Sing and act out the nursery rhyme together.
